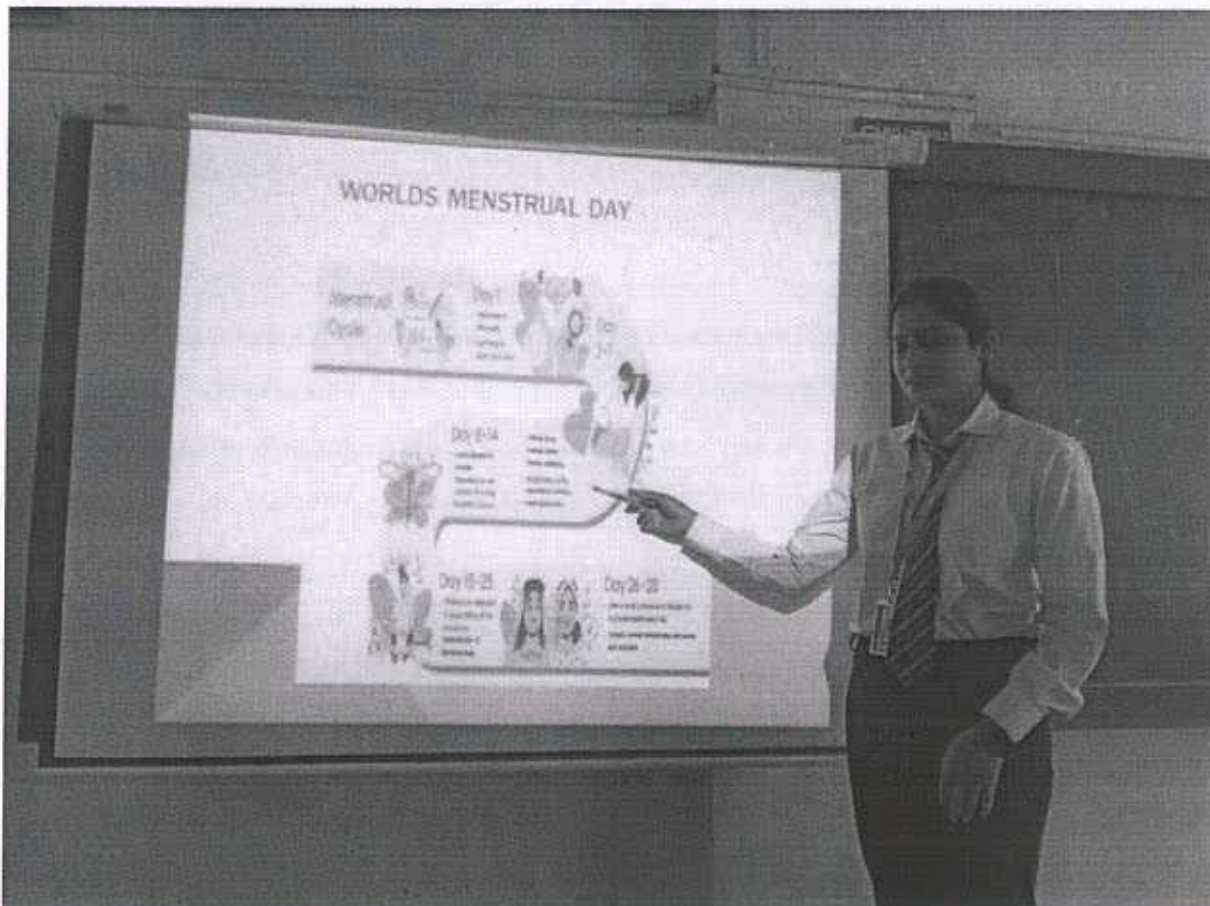

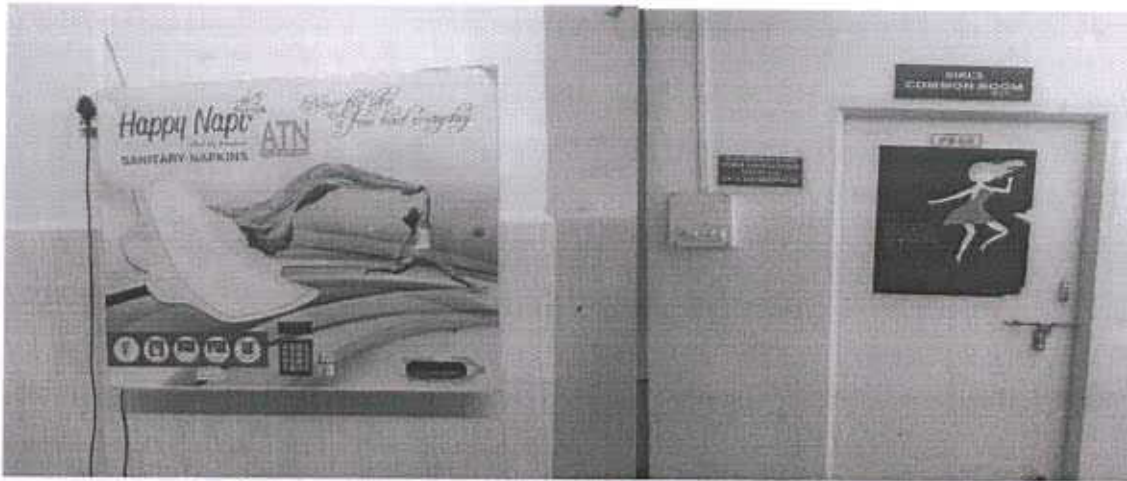


3. OUTCOME :

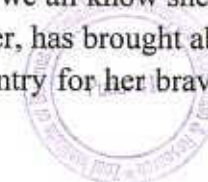
