Objectives:

1. To have 360 view about the process implemented by various Committees/cell
2. To help for the overall Institute's development.

Methodology:

- i. The feedback comprises of multiple dimensions regarding the various academic, training/placement, event/ activities, infrastructure.
- ii. The Feedback on is collected from stakeholders by circulating the Feedback Forms.
- iii. The frequency of conducting the feedback is finalised by the related committee.
- iv. The committee frames/reframes the feedback parameters. It considers the earlier feedback outcome and then taken decision to make changes in the existing process.
- v. It finalises the process and take a due permission from the Director; Member secretary of Committees.

Analysis:

- i. The data is compiled and analysed through statistical tools. It is given for deliberation to the Director





- ii. The Action taken report is prepared and is tabled for discussion at every committee including IQAC, any changes in process are discussed.
- iii. For Academic feedback a benchmark of feedback is being considered, if the feedback is above desired feedback, an appreciation letter is given which further appraise faculty member in form of an appreciation letter and further is considered for annual appraisals.

While collecting feedback from students, following points are being considered:

- i) Anonymous – to encourage impartial and honest feedback
- ii) In Class/event – to ensure high rate of participation.
- iii) Comprehensive – Feedback is collected on various aspects of institute
- v) Third party analysis – objective analysis by the computer cell.
- vi) Actionable inputs - based on the collected and analysed forms, actions are being taken such as conduct/non conduct of any activity, appraising faculty, counselling faculty, plan initiative

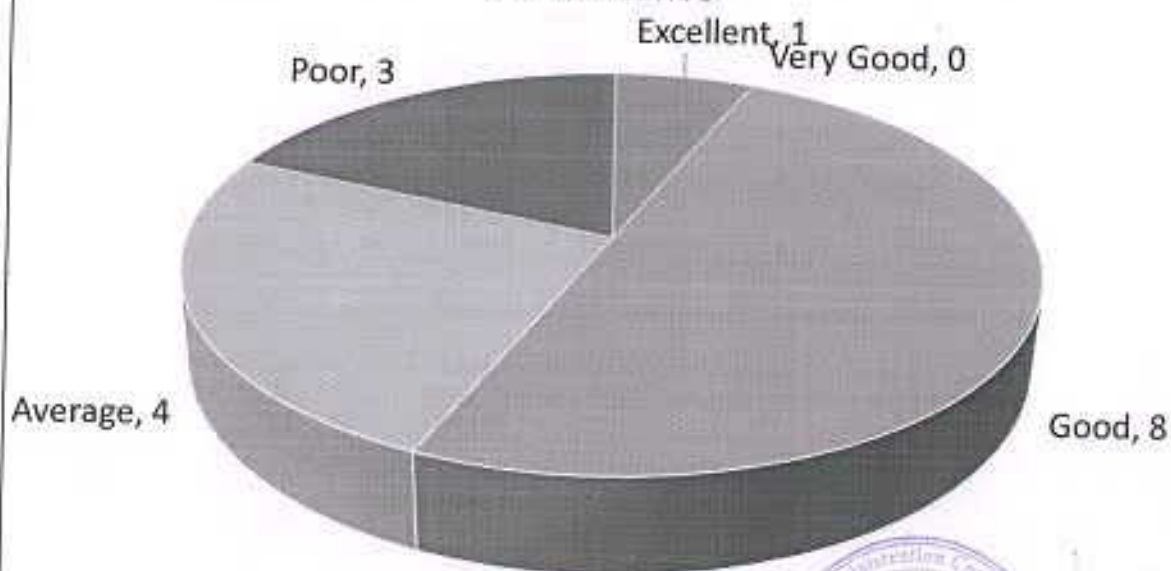

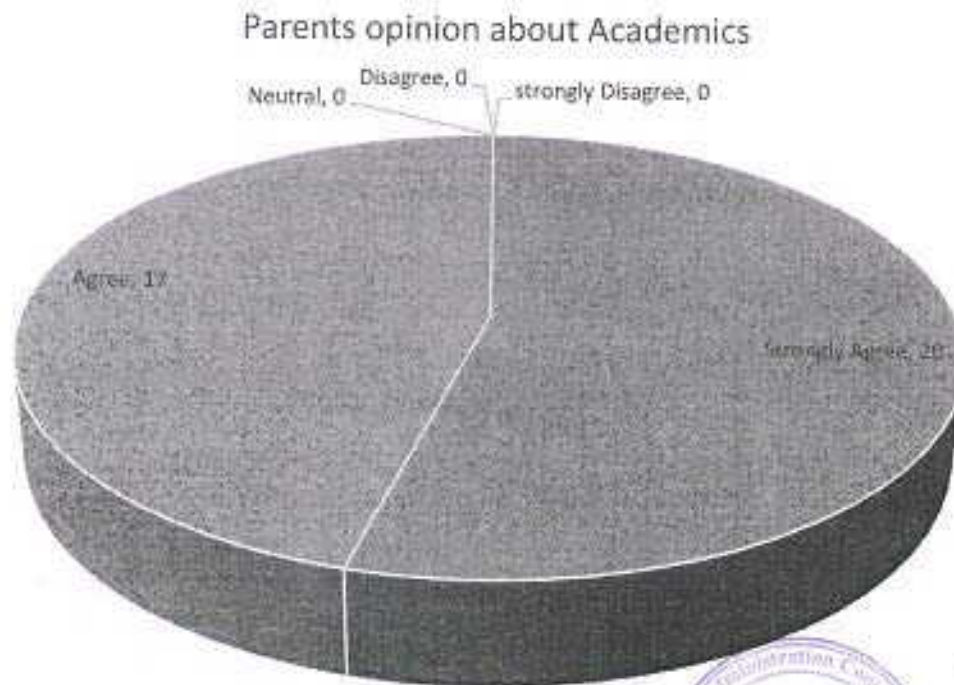


Table 2: Table showing Parents opinion about Infrastructure and Lab facilities

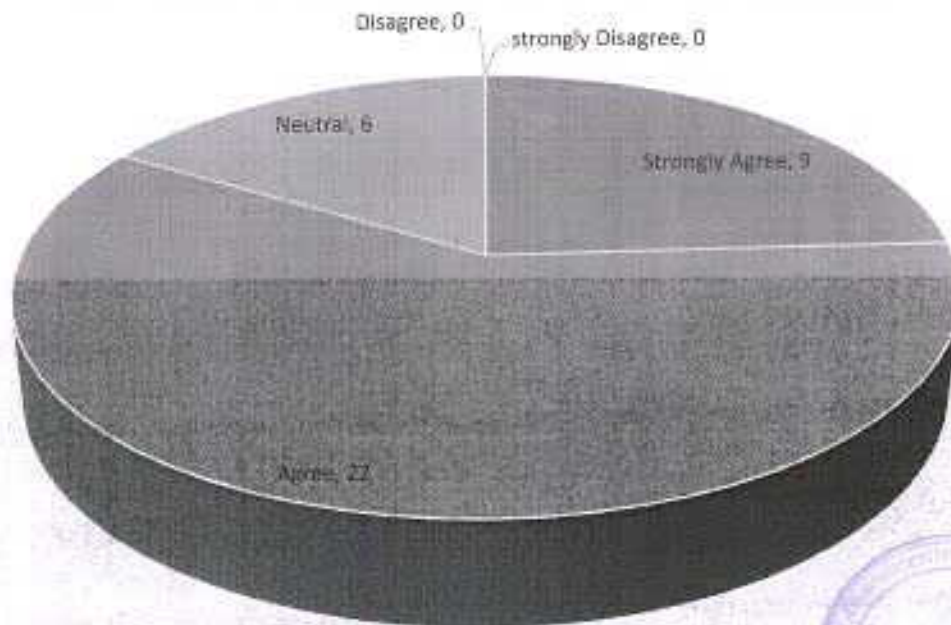


Table 3: Table showing Parents opinion about Faculty

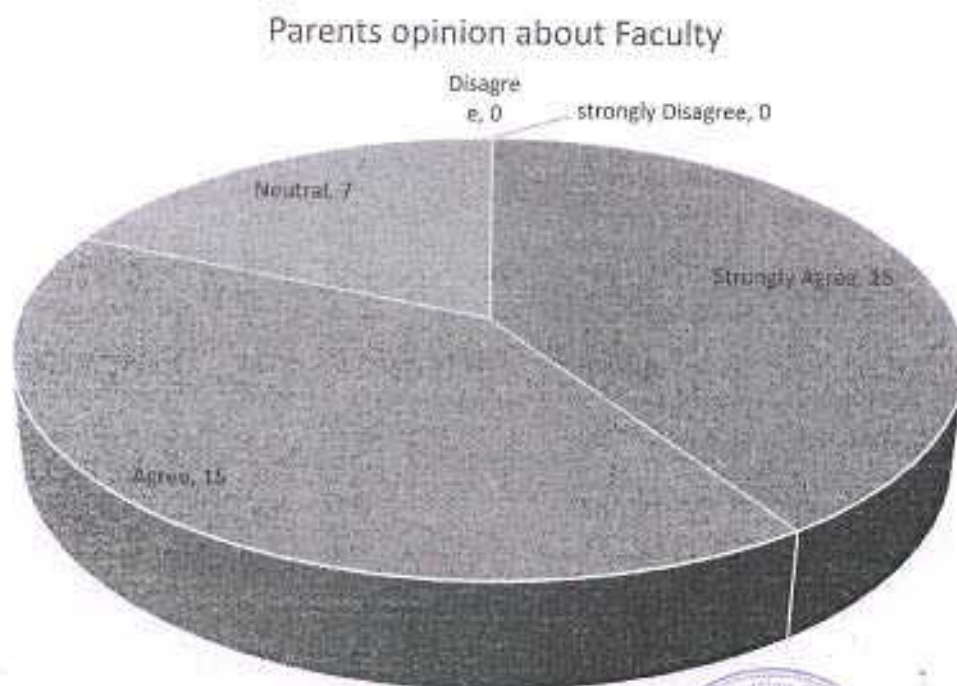


Table 4: Table showing Parents opinion about Canteen facilities

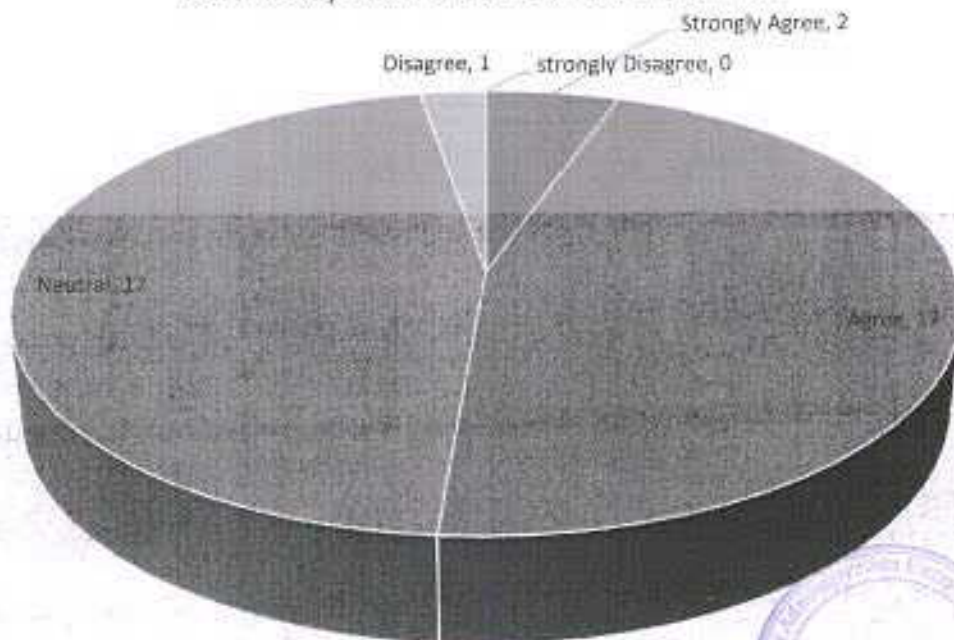


Table 5: Table showing Parents opinion about Library

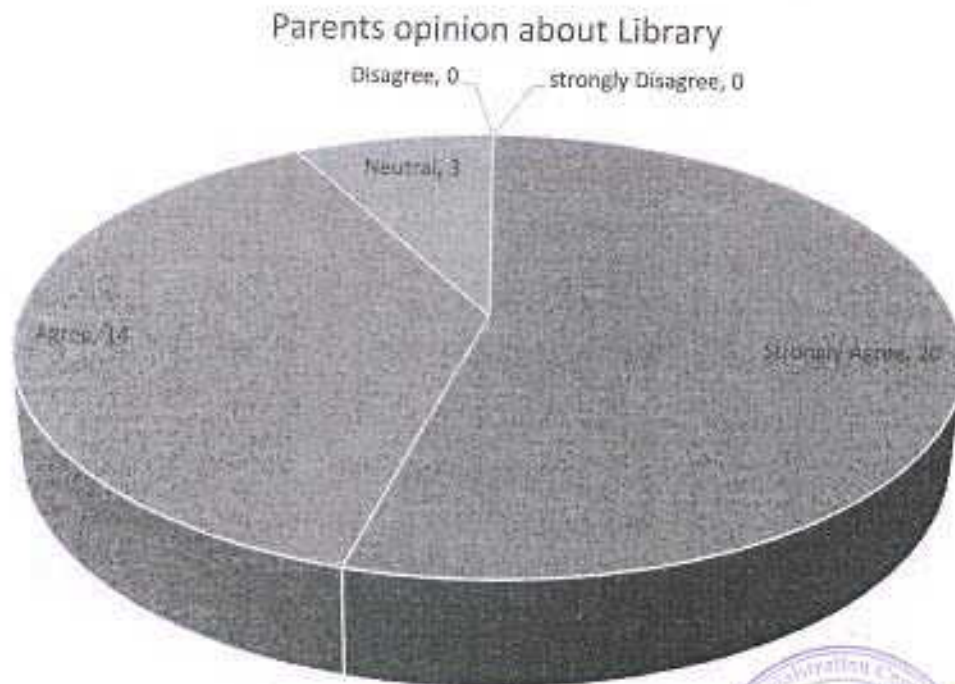



Table 6: Table showing Parents opinion about office staff

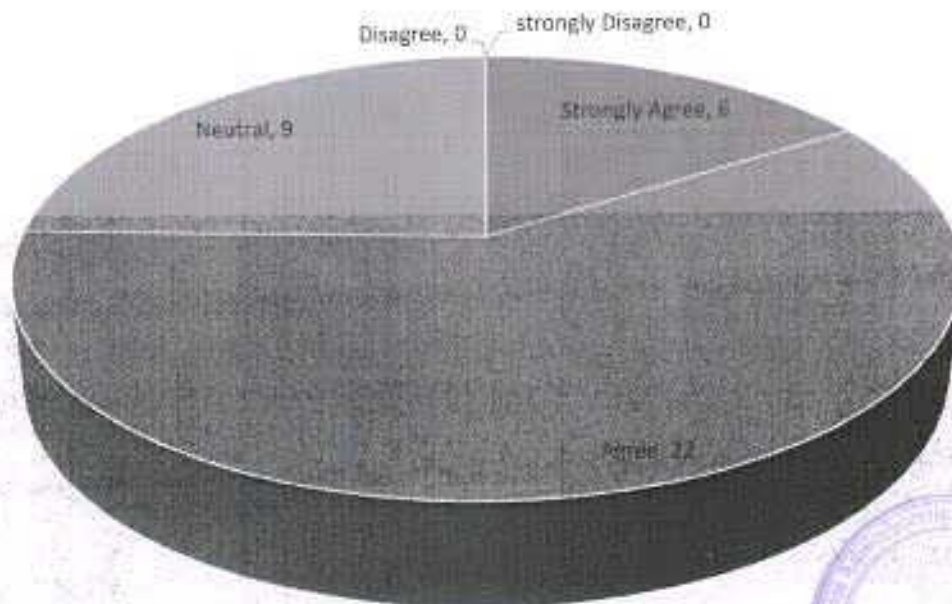


Table 7: Table showing Parents opinion about Hostel Facilities

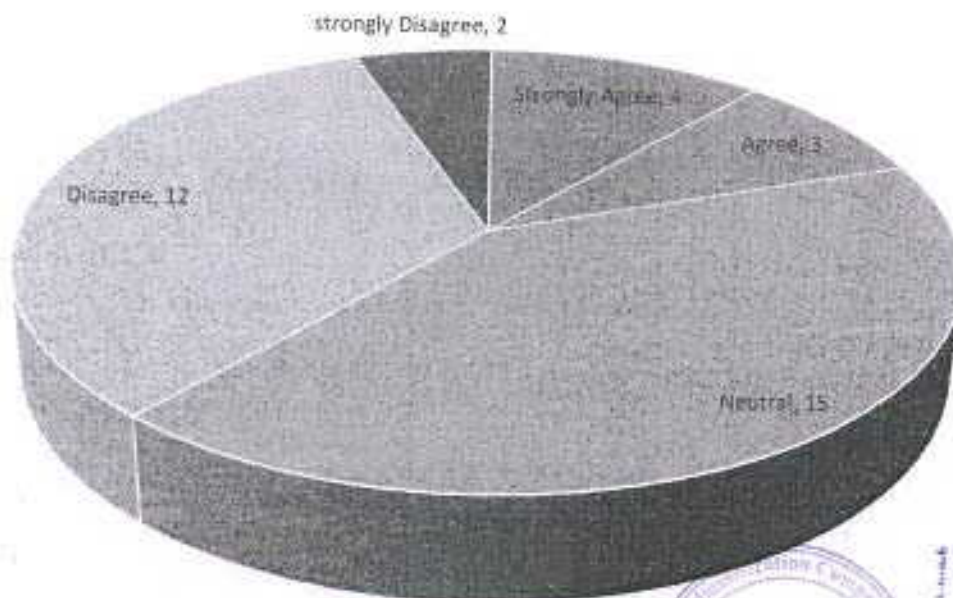


Table 8: Table showing Parents opinion about Education Resources

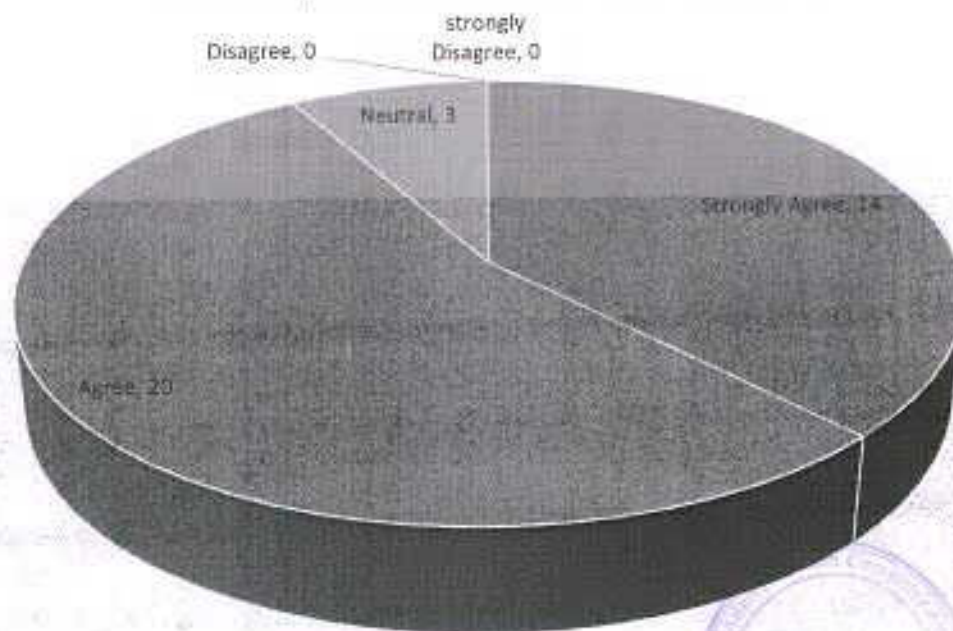


Table 9: Table showing Parents opinion about Admission Procedure

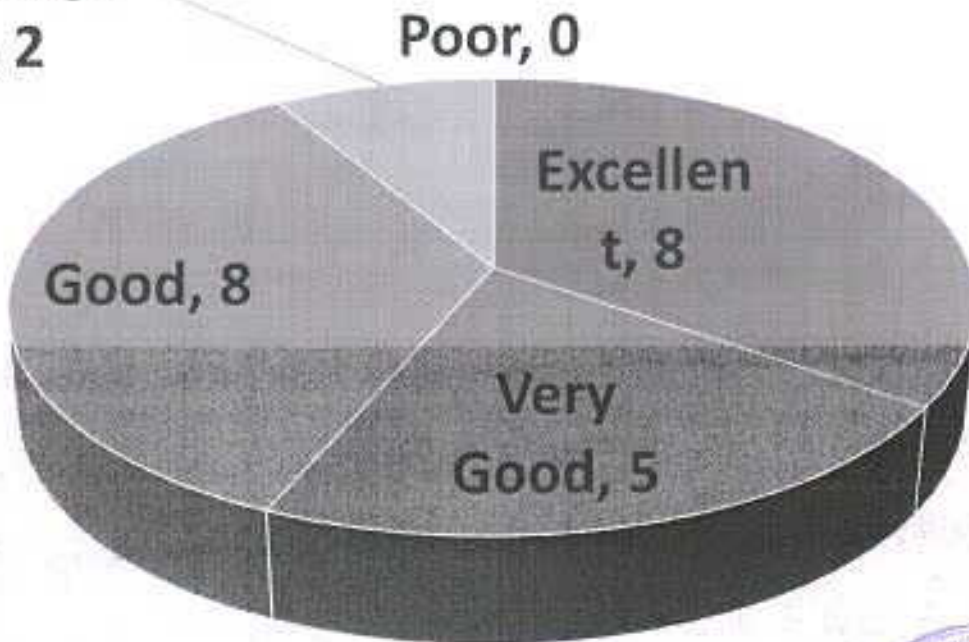

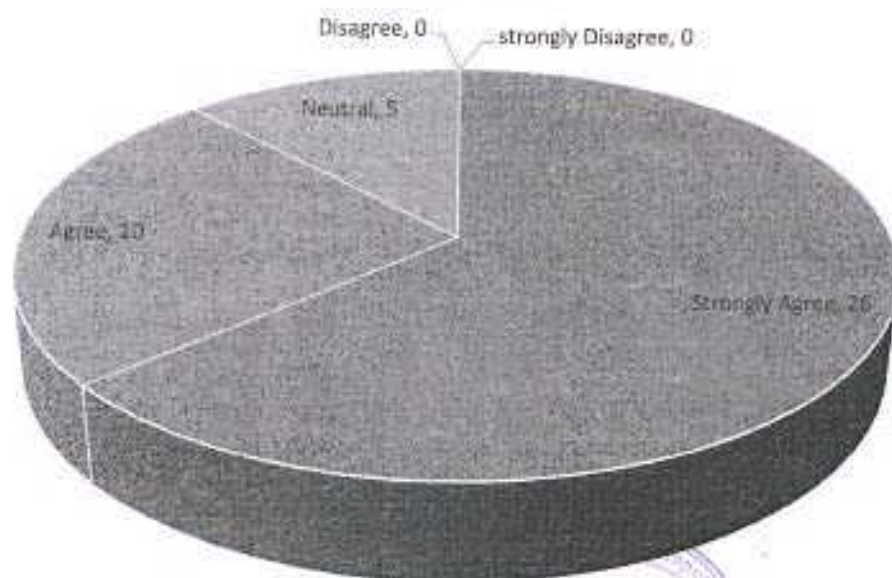

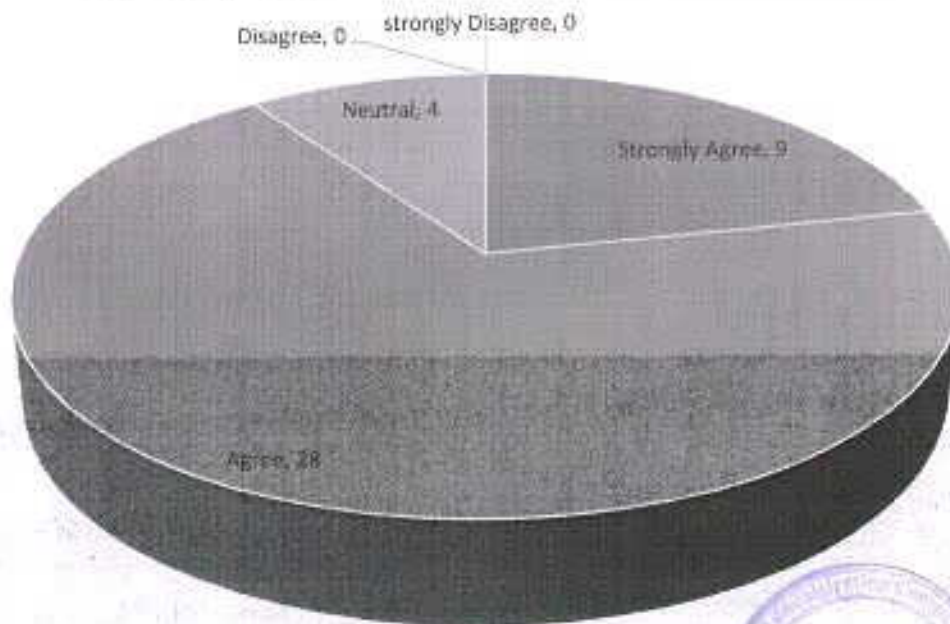

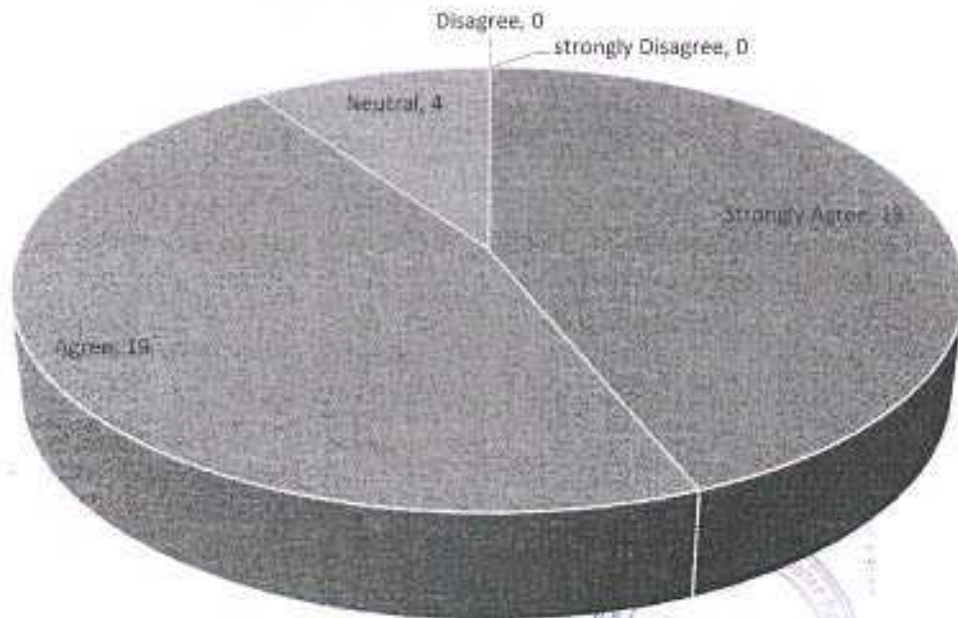


Table 4: Table showing Alumni opinion about Canteen facilities

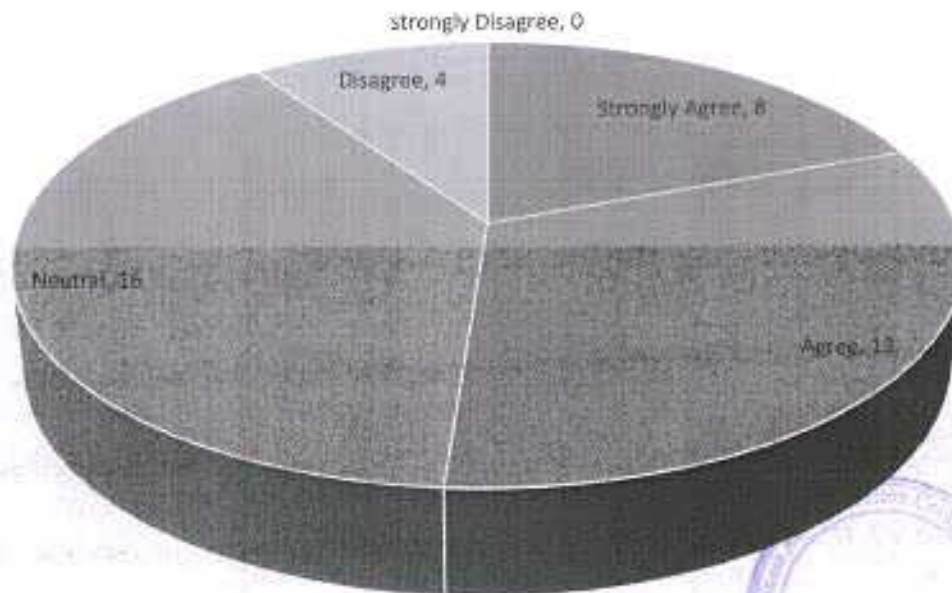


Table 5: Table showing Alumni opinion about Library

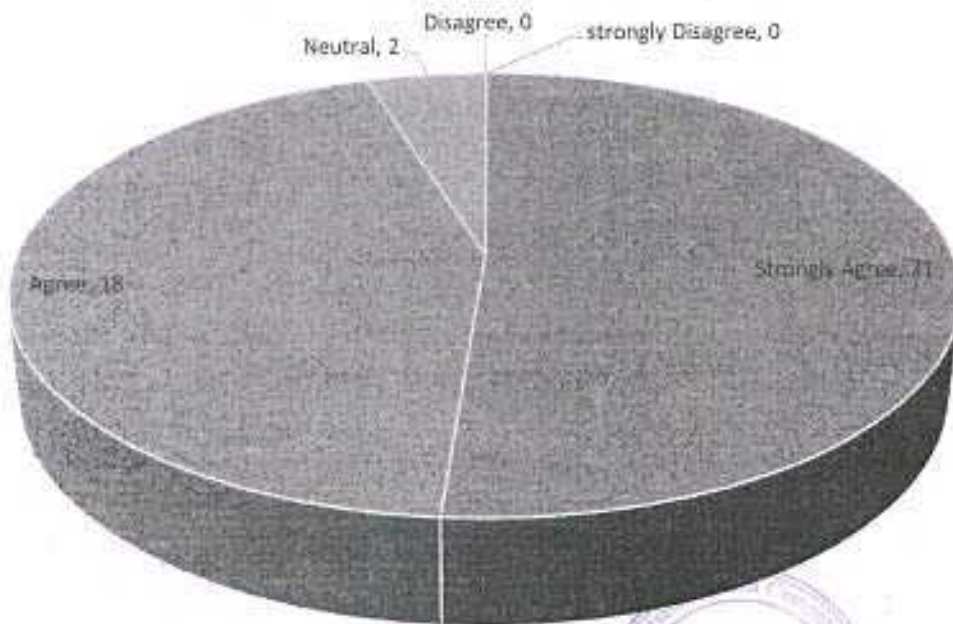


Table 6: Table showing Alumni opinion about office staff

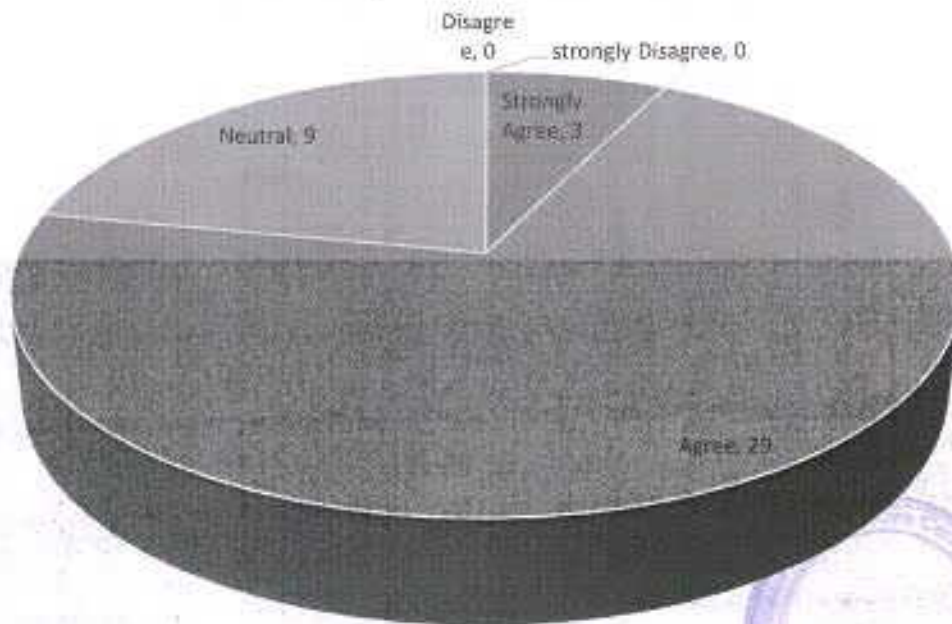


Table 7: Table showing Alumni opinion about Hostel Facilities

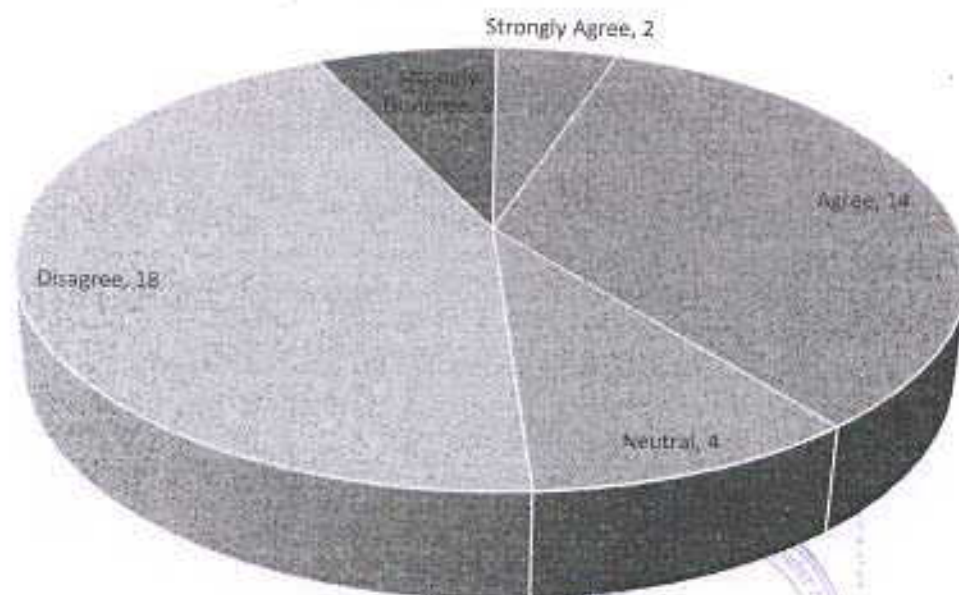


Table 8: Table showing Alumni opinion about Education Resources

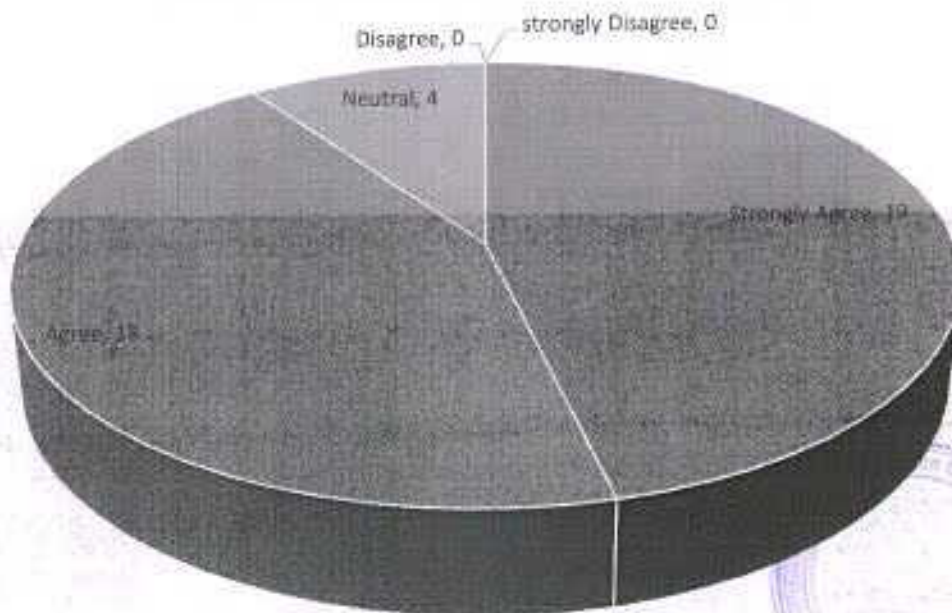
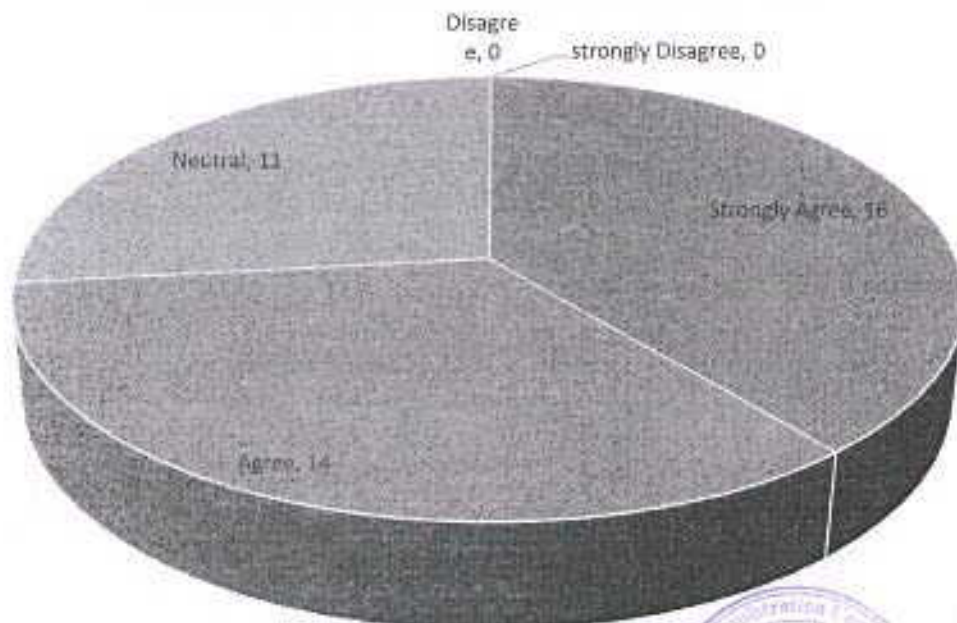

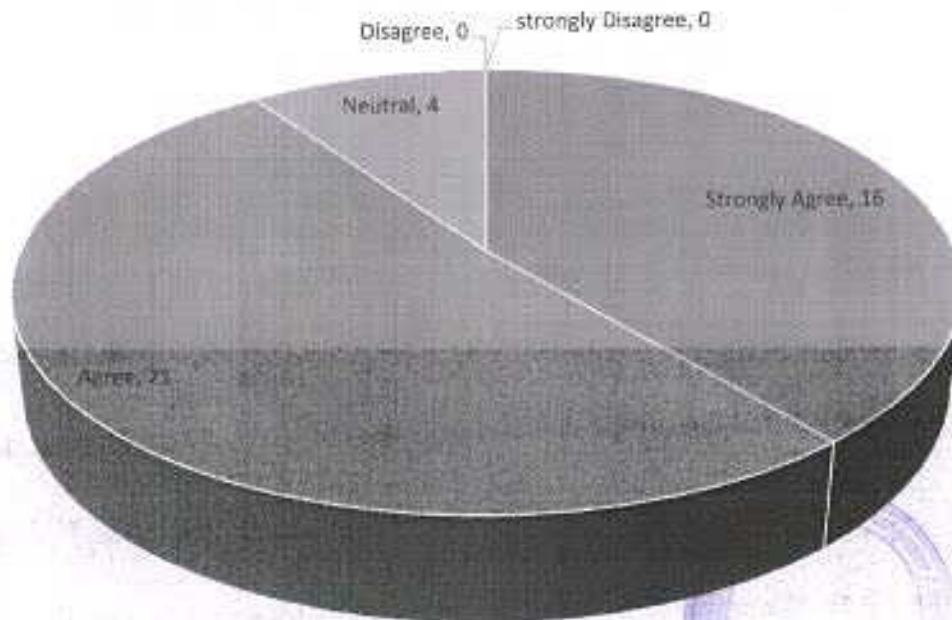

Chart showing facilities at ZIBACAR

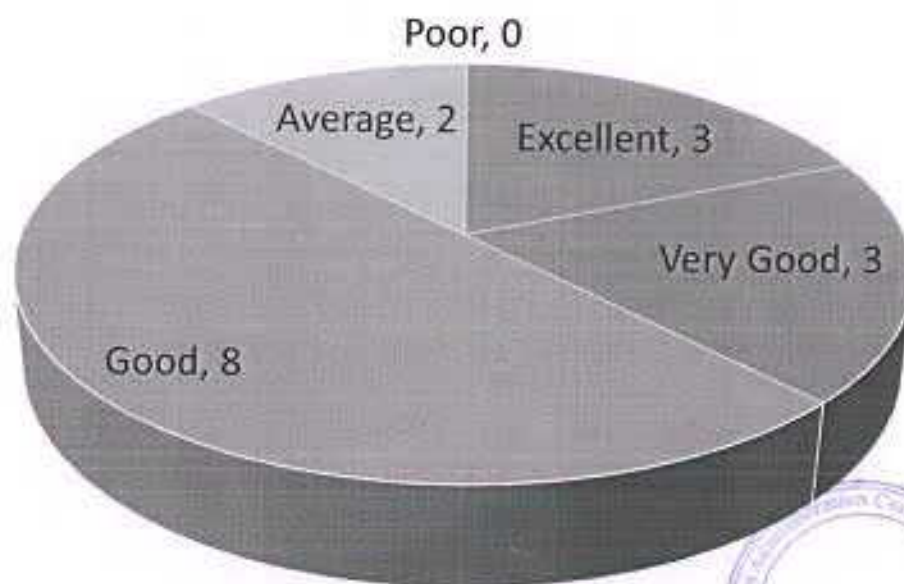
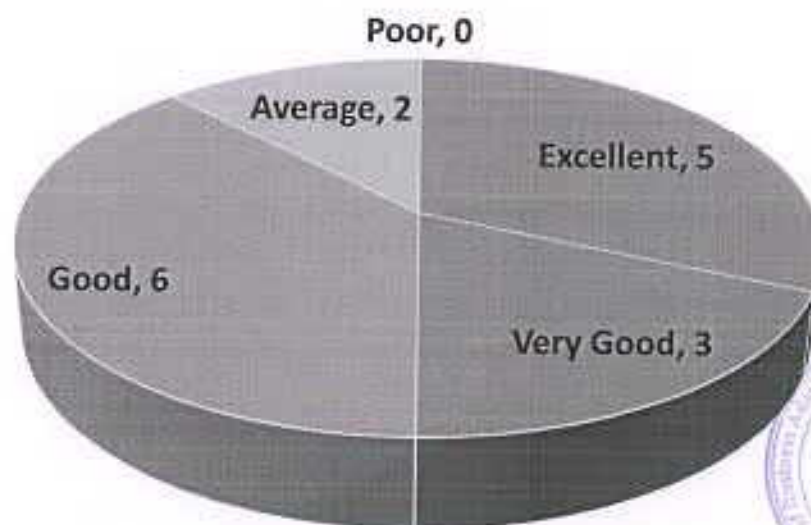

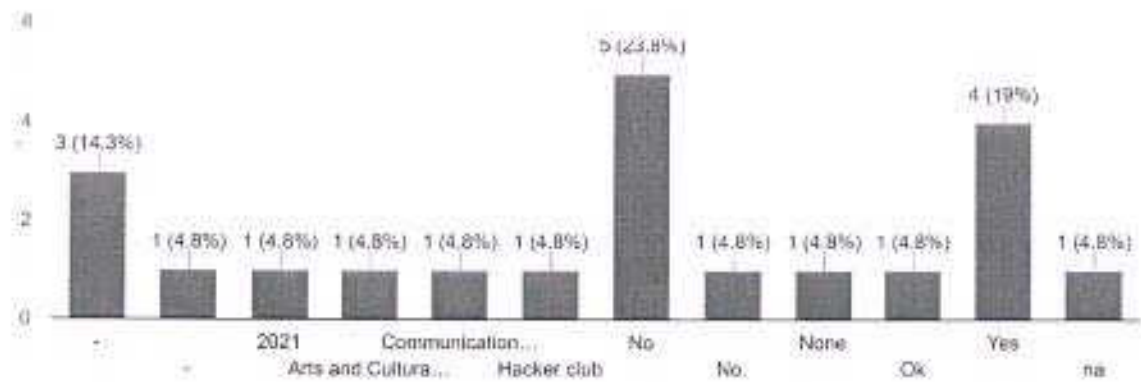
Bar chart showing the number of responses for various club activities across five age groups: 18-24 years, 25-34 years, 35-44 years, 45-54 years, and 55+ years.
