10. IMPACT OF THE EVENT

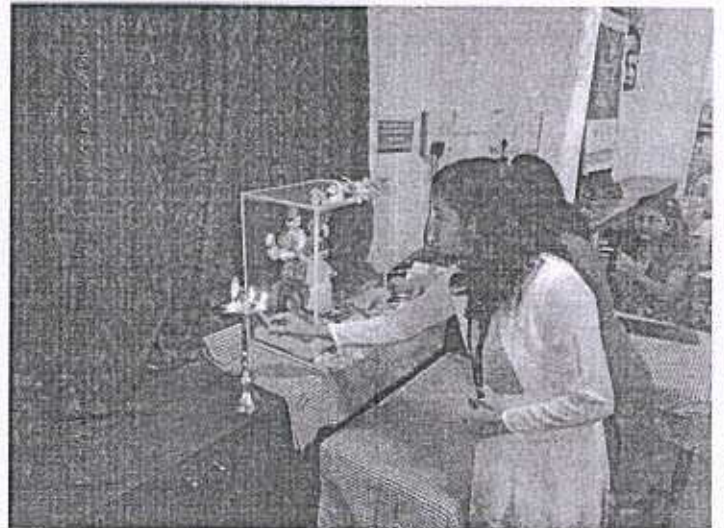
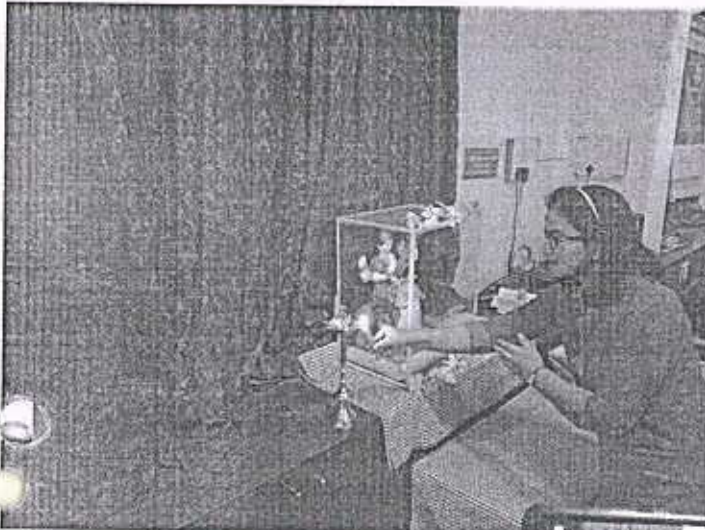
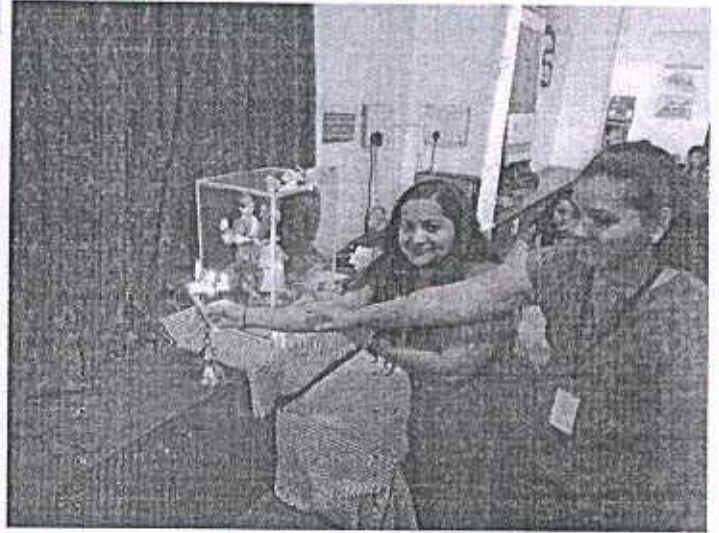
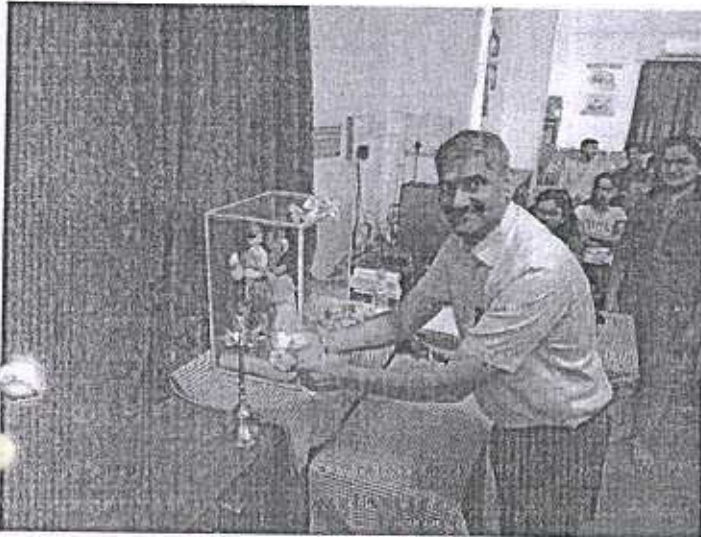

Topic: Jijau and Modern generation

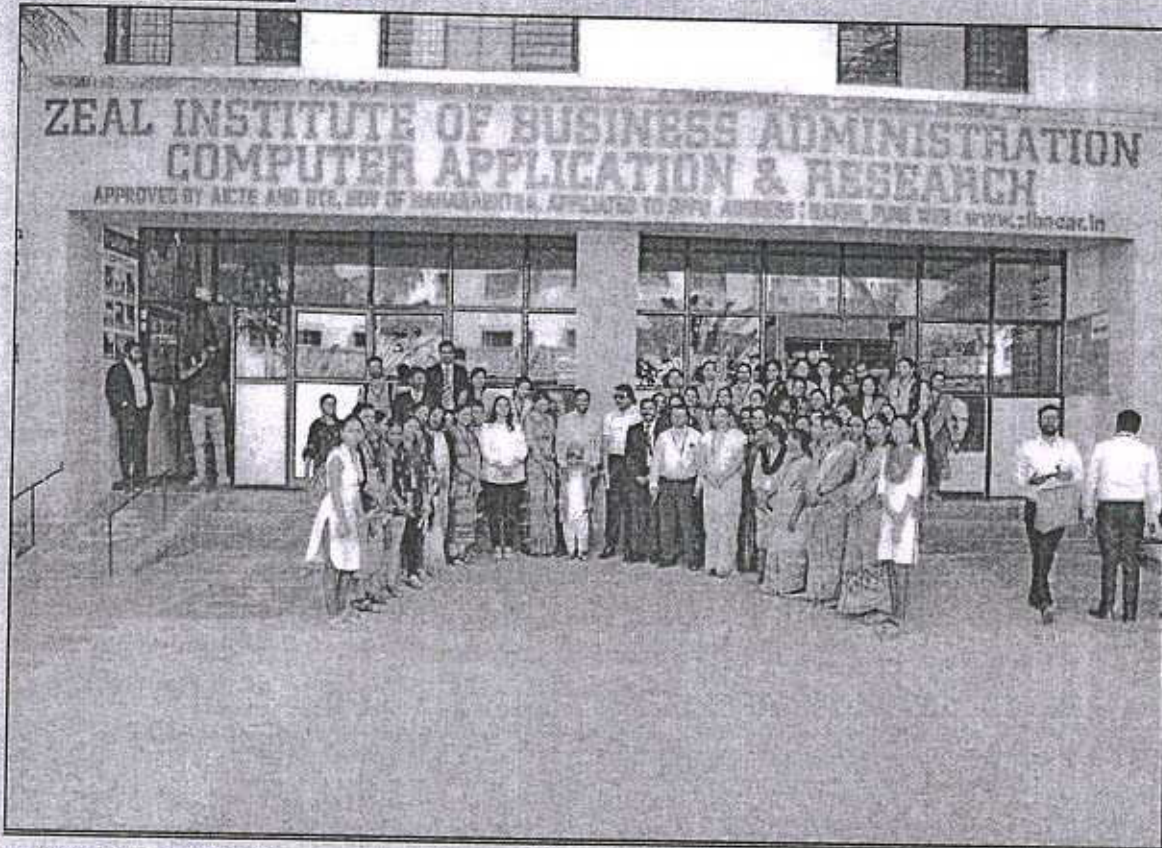

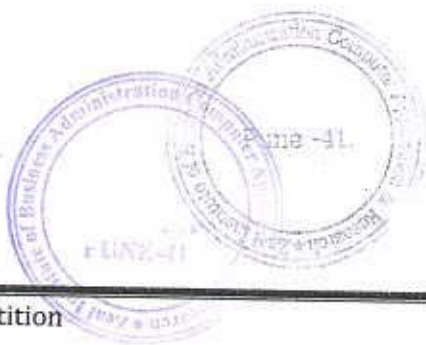

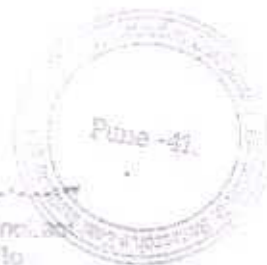

2. CONCEPTION OF THE PROGRAMME

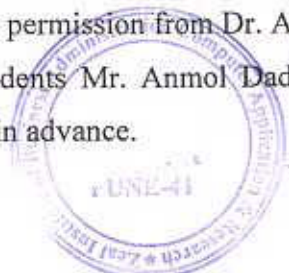

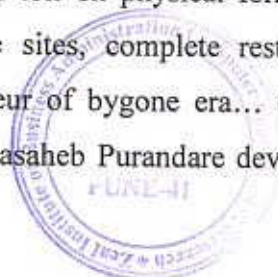

7. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Standing as silent sentinels to history are the 350-odd forts of Maharashtra. They are the last lingering memories of Maratha Empire. Surviving forts are the tangible link between contemporary society of Maharashtra & the era of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. Shivaji Maharaj established independent Maratha Empire from these forts. hence historical value of these forts is immeasurable. In extremely adverse conditions Shivaji Maharaj realised his dream of 'Swarajya' because of these forts. However, today none of these historical site & forts can be seen in its true glory. Time, human negligence and inadequate heritage protection policies have taken toll on physical form of these irreplaceable assets. As per the current legislation for heritage sites, complete restoration & reconstruction is not permissible. One can only guess the grandeur of bygone era... cannot see it...cannot experience it. Hence, to address this situation Shri Babasaheb Purandare developed the



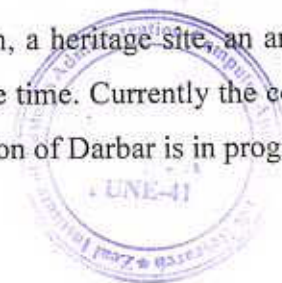
notion of 'Shivasrushti' - an epic heritage park....a majestic enclave...one stop treasure house which will offer a holistic experience of inspiring Maratha history...

Shivasrushti will be in the form of collage of fort architecture. One can experience all the salient features of lost fort architecture at Shivasrushti. The whole program of Shivasrushti is shown through the well directed documentary film. The cultural park itself was a live fort bustling with numerous activities of that era. The first phase of this project - Sarkar Wada and library are complete & gloriously standing on site at Ambegaon, Pune. The Sarkar Wada is an interpretation for the entire project. It is well equipped with an administrative centre, research library, multipurpose hall and exhibition galleries. Contemporary society and future generations should observe experience and follow the philosophy of visionary king and valour of his soldiers is the main objective of Pratishthan for creating this mega project. The entrance of Sarkarwada has a large open space, currently used to teach horse-riding. As we enter the main gate, a panoramic construction is ready to greet. It feels as if we have actually walked into a palace. The main door of this palace is nearly 15 ft. high completed with spikes that were originally made to control rampage by elephants during a war. As we walk inside, murals and paintings decorate the passage. The courtyard has a musical fountain too. There are two large halls on either sides of the courtyard. Both have ample natural light. The 'Wada' is 2 storied high as of now with a full-fledged library, administrative office and seating places. The top floor has air conditioned rooms for special guests.

Then we visited to the library. It has various books related to Shri. Chattrapati Shivaji Maharaj history. There are some rarest books. About 1000 books are in the library. These books are kept in the cupboards which are specially made as per the ancient time. There is an open access to these books. The table is placed centrally, where people can read these books for their study. These books are not allowed to be taken home.

Dr Ajit Apte guided us throughout the visit and explained each and every thing in detailed.

It is unique in many ways as it could be a royal retreat, a museum, a heritage site, an architectural wonder, a piece of art or a leaf out of history book - all at the same time. Currently the construction of Bhavani Mata temple is on the way of completion and construction of Darbar is in progress.

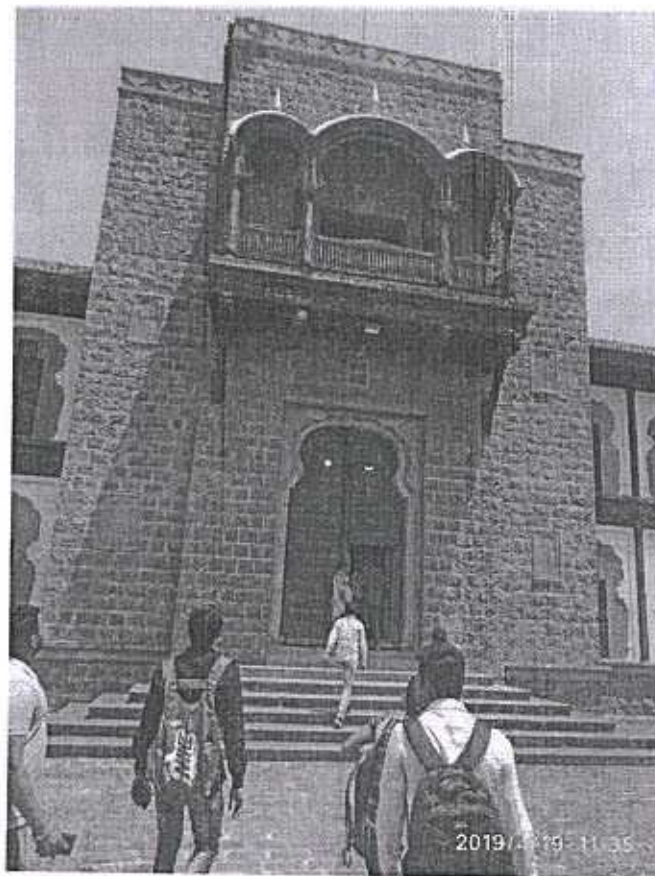

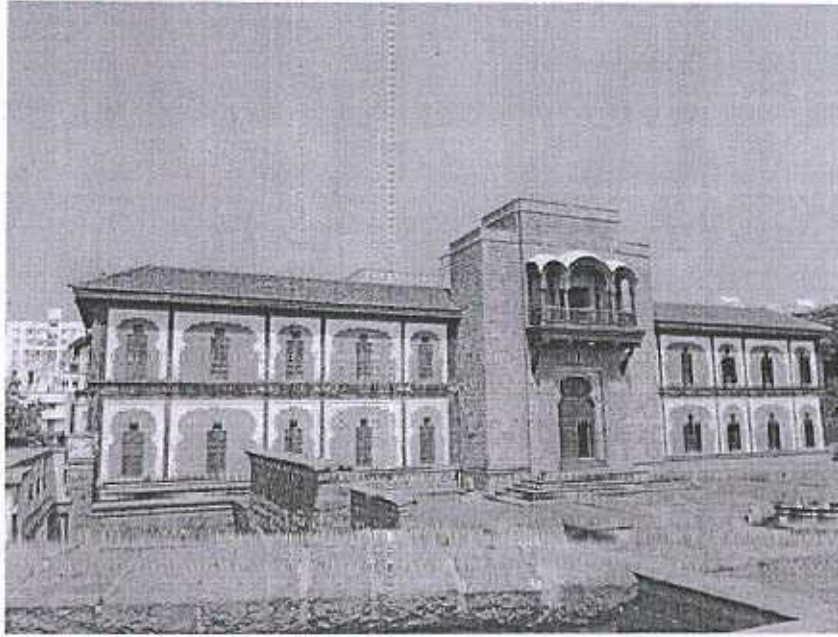

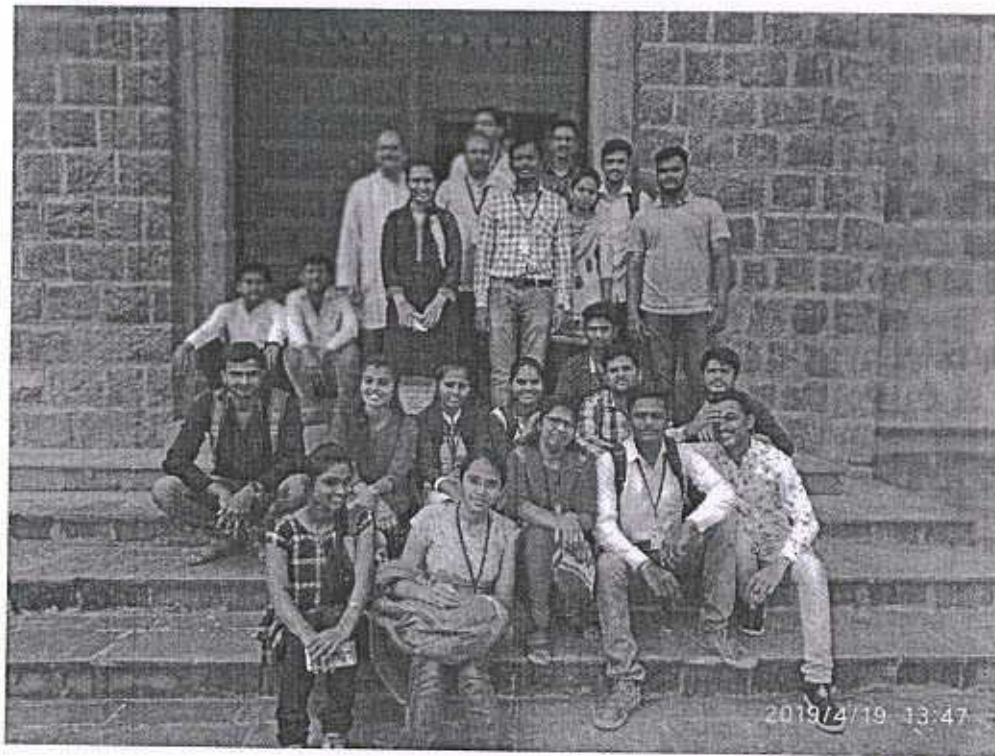

And while there are cheer leaders, they do not really require a single leader to direct and drive the team towards the goal. The whole team is a self driven, self motivated unit focused around one clear goal.

2. Openness & Understanding: For making a human pyramid, it is very important to have an understanding of everyones strength and weaknesses. In an environment where everyone does not know each other extremely well, an environment of openness and trust become paramount as people get allocated to do different roles within the pyramid. 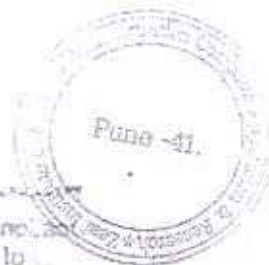

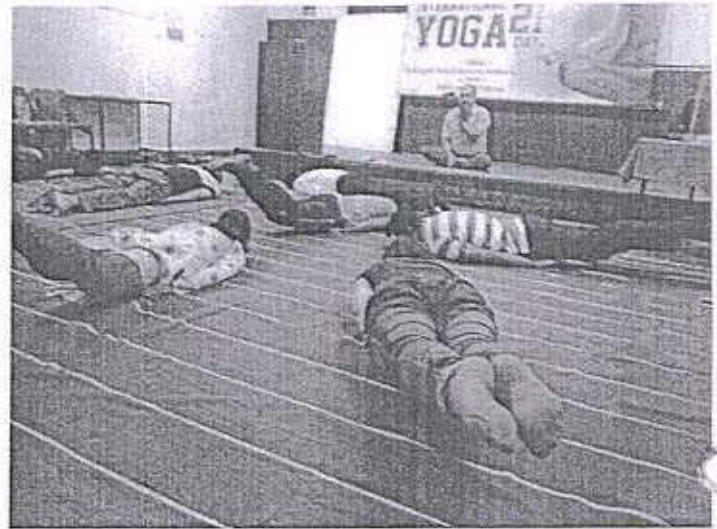

Navaratri is an important major festival and is celebrated all over India, Pakistan and Nepal. Diwali the festival of lights is celebrated twenty days after Dasera. Though there are in total five types of Navaratri that come in a year, Sharad Navaratri and Vasant Navaratri are the most popular one. Hence, the term Navaratri is being used for both, but mainly Sharad Navaratri here.

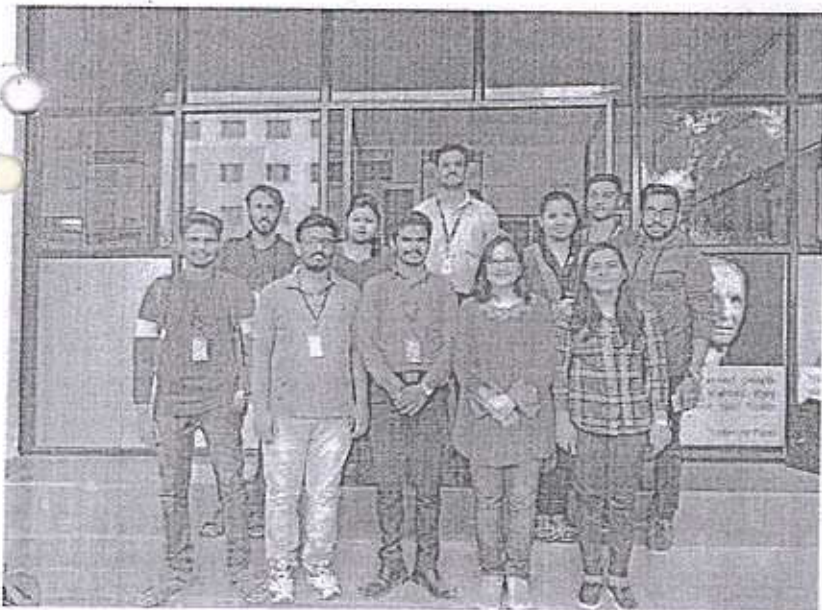

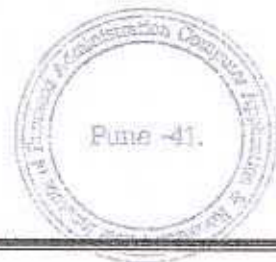

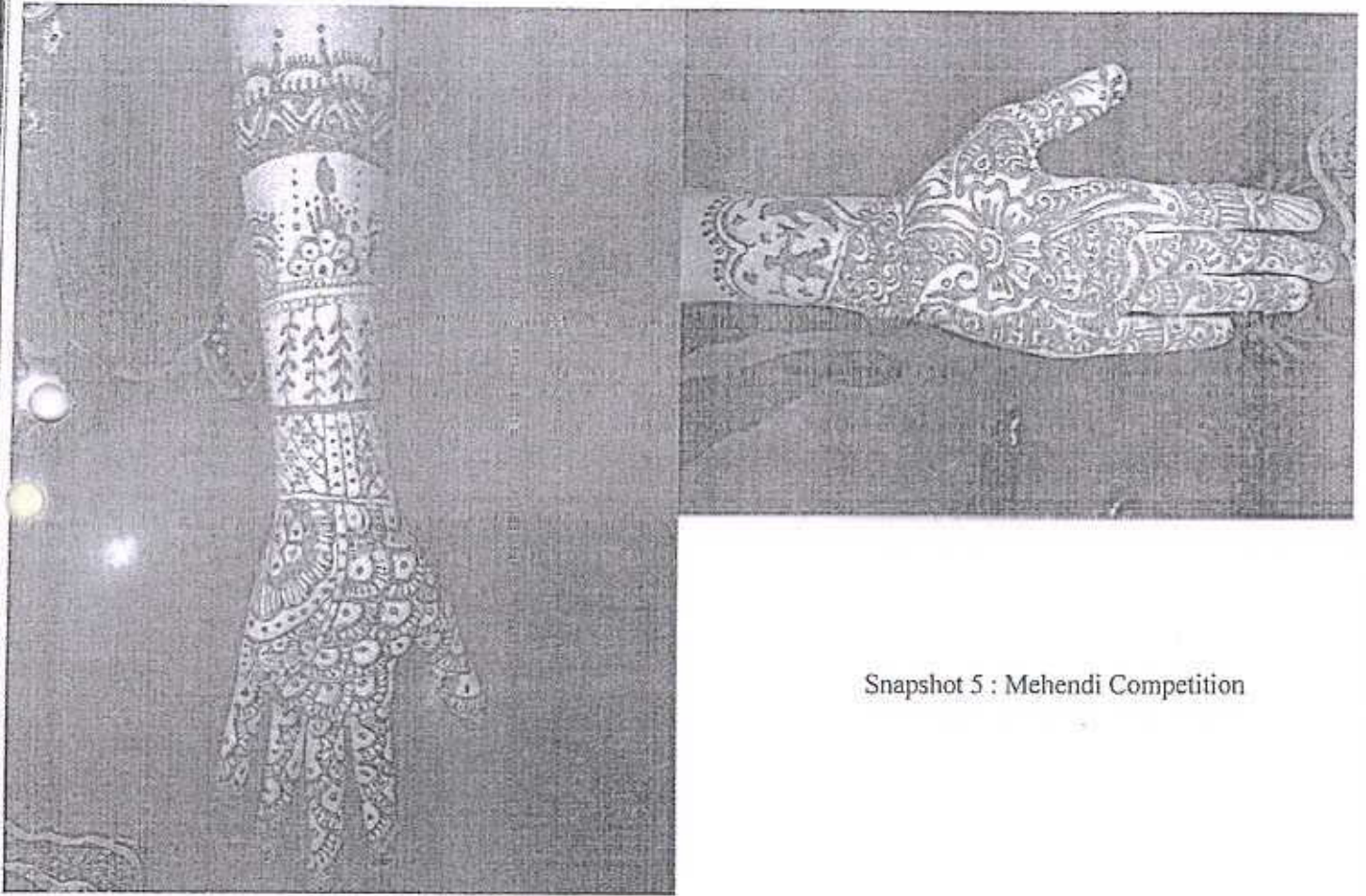

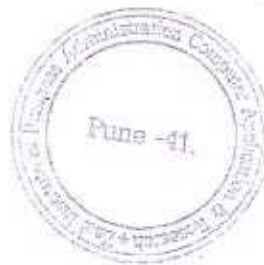

7. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Jyotirao Govindrao Phule was born in Satara district of Maharashtra in 1827. His father, Govindrao was a vegetable-vendor at Poona. Jyotirao's family belonged to 'mali' caste and their original title was 'Gorhay'. Malis were considered as an inferior caste by the Brahmins and were shunned socially. Jyotirao's father and uncles served as florists, so the family came to be known as 'Phule'. Jyotirao's mother passed away when he was just nine months old.

Jyotirao was an intelligent boy but due to the poor financial condition at home, he had to stop his studies at an early age. He started helping his father by working on the family's farm. Recognising the talent of the child prodigy, a neighbour persuaded his father to send him to school. In 1841, Jyotirao got admission in the Scottish Mission's High School, Poona, and completed his education in 1847. There, he met Sadashiv Ballal Govande, a Brahmin, who remained his close friend throughout his life. At the age of just thirteen years, Jyotirao was married to Savitribai.

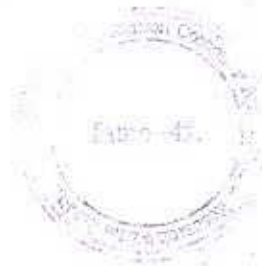


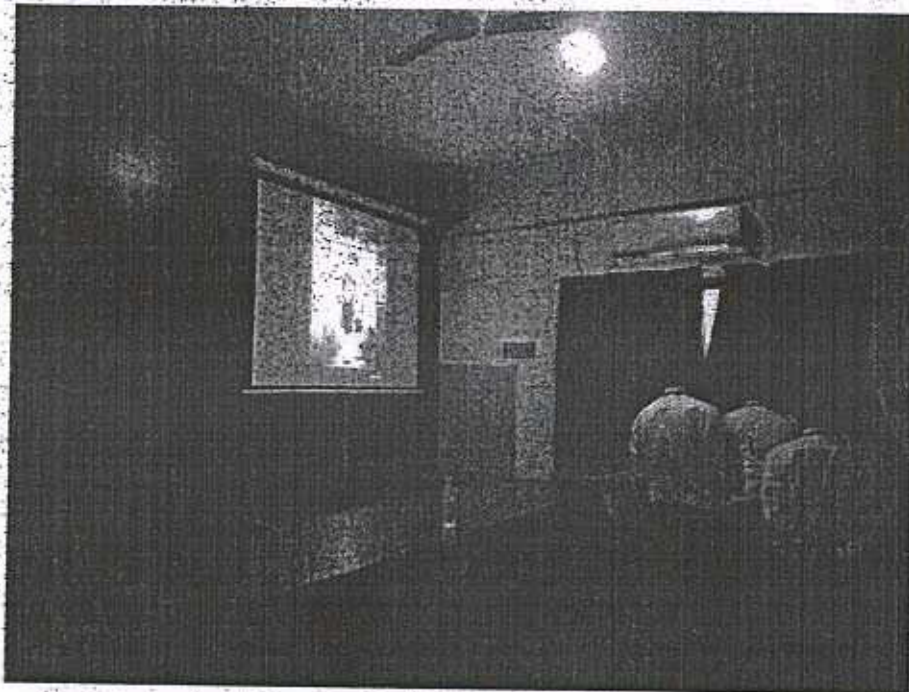
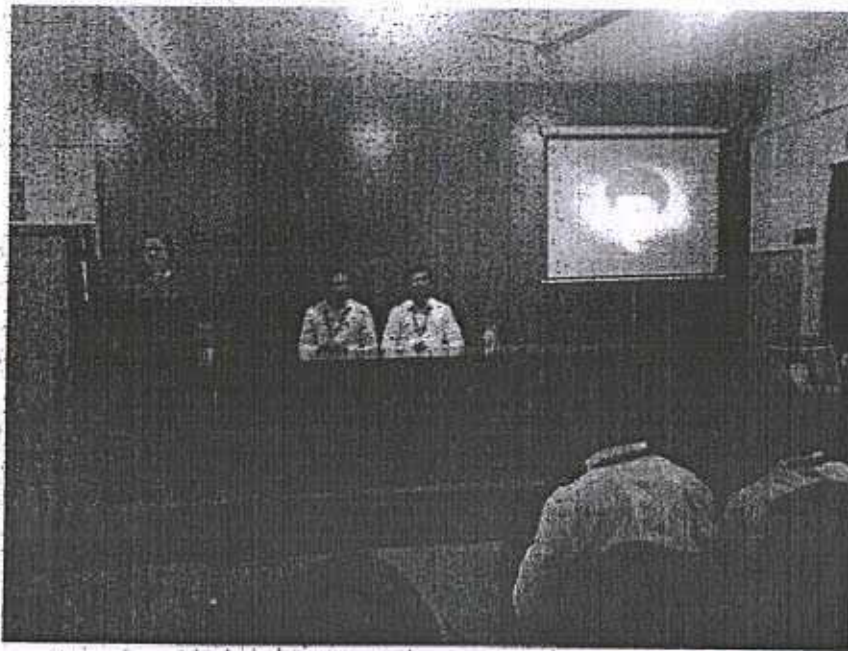
In 1848, an incident sparked off Jyotiba's quest against the social injustice of caste discrimination and incited a social revolution in the Indian society. Jyotirao was invited to attend the wedding of one of his friends who belonged to an upper cast Brahmin family. But at the wedding the relatives of the bridegroom insulted and abused Jyotiba when they came to know about his origins. Jyotirao left the ceremony and made up his mind to challenge the prevailing caste-system and social restrictions. He made it his life's work to hammer away tirelessly at the helms of social majoritarian domination and aimed at emancipation of all human beings that were subjected to this social deprivation.

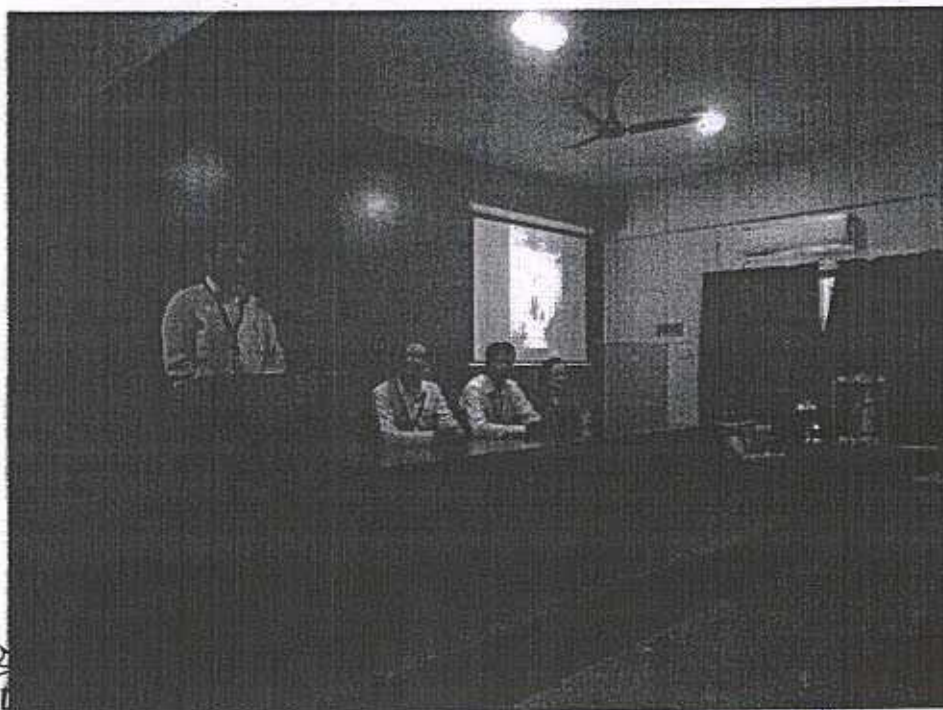
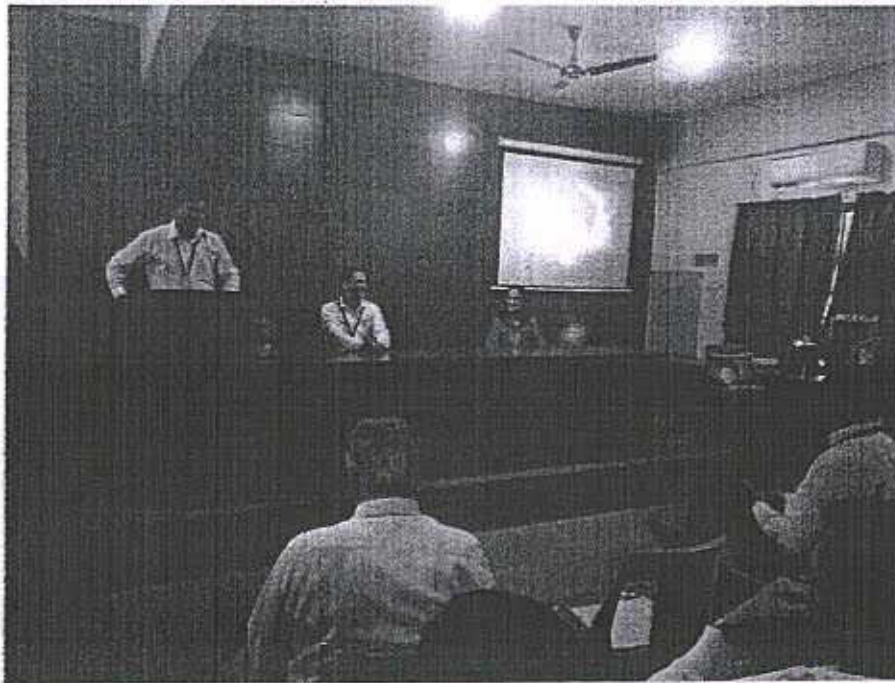
