## 6. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Faculty members from Zeal College of Engineering and Research, Zeal Polytechnic, Zeal Institute of Management and Computer Application and our own Zeal Institute of Business Administration, Computer Application and Research arrived at 10:45 am to the Digital Language Lab where they registered. The program begun at 11:00 am where Mr. Bhaskar Lendave, Librarian-ZIBACAR introduced Mr. G. K. Upadhyaya to the audience.

Mr. Upadhyaya, explained the significance of Research to the audience. He convincingly told even the popular search engines are unable to provide required articles efficiently and discussed that then discussed need of using E-journals. He later introduced EBSCO as a customizable, intuitive search experience that caters to user needs and preferences at every level of research, with more than 375 full-text and secondary databases available.

He discussed following points in the presentation:

- Basic and Advanced Search Screens to accommodate both novice and experienced researchers.
- The Guided Style Advanced Search Screen assists users in creating more targeted searches with more sophisticated limiters.
- Enables seamless connectivity with linking to and from a variety of resources, which can be set up by library administrators.
- The Digital Archives Viewer provides an exciting content format with a wide range of features and functionality of interest to all types of users.
- Multilanguage searching enables users to search in any Latin-based language as well as Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Greek, Cyrillic, Hebrew and Arabic. The

EBSCOhost interface has been localized into 25 non-English languages, with more in development, providing non-English speaking users with an easier, more intuitive search experience.

- Provides users with a password-protected storage option. Once a personalized folder account (My EBSCOhost) has been created, users can save individual search results, search histories, persistent links to searches, Search Alerts and Journal Alerts across multiple sessions, for use in future sessions. EBSCO's My EBSCOhost folder functionality allows users to sort and efficiently manage results within multiple, customizable folders.
- Search Alerts save time by enabling users to create automatic email deliveries to designated recipients of new results for their most recently conducted searches.
- Journal Alerts provide automatic email notification whenever a new issue of the designated journal has been added to a specified database.
- EBSCO's One-Step RSS Feed Alerts allow users who wish to receive updated EBSCOhostsearch results on a newsreader or web page to instantly capture a syndicated RSS feed URL whenever they conduct a search in EBSCOhost.

The shared all interfaces regarding articles searching, their utilization and analysis.

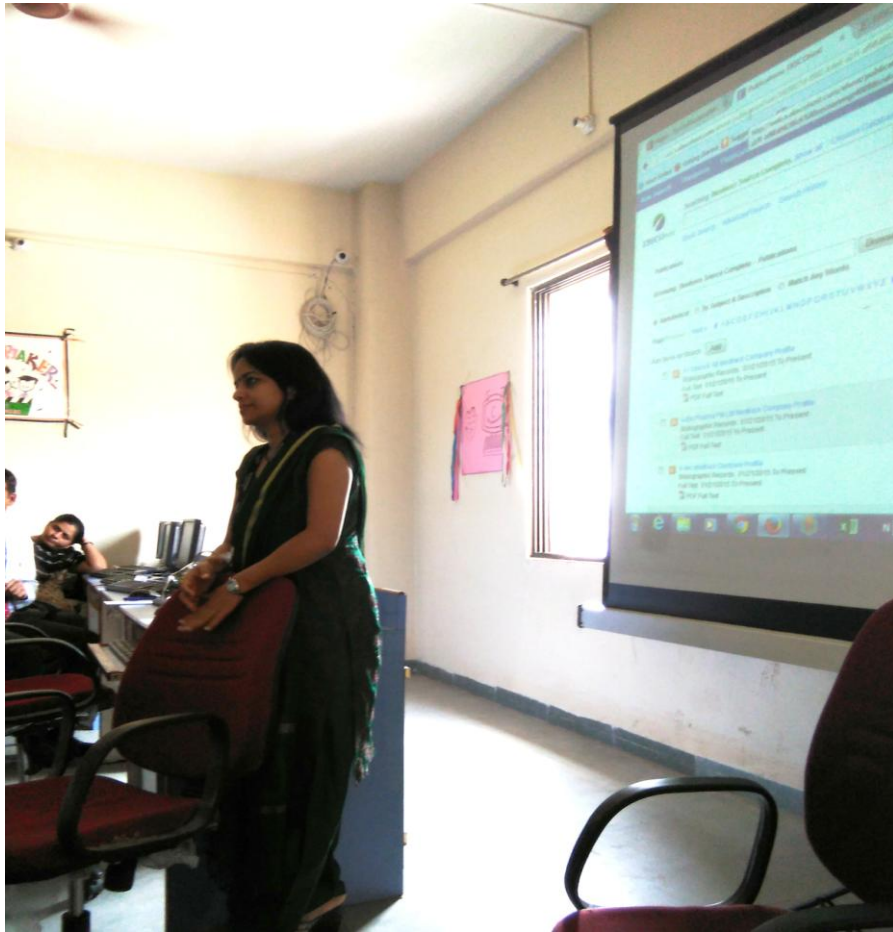

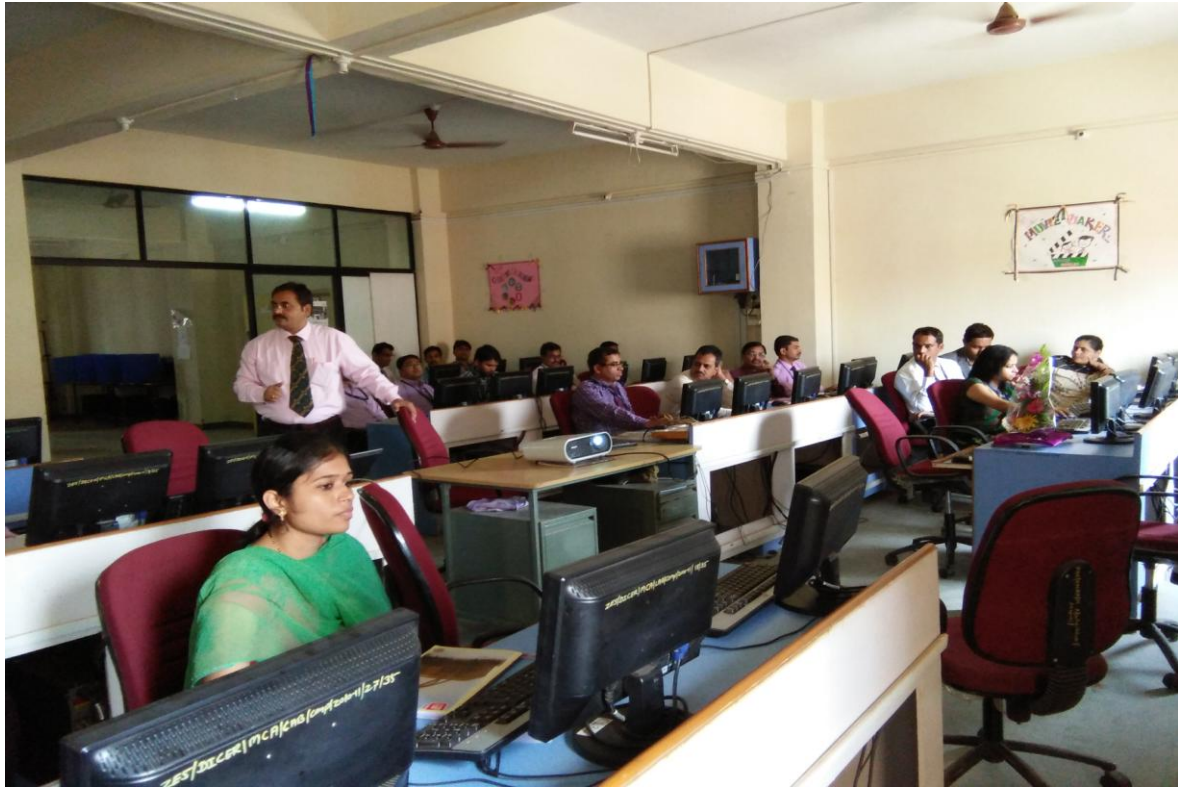

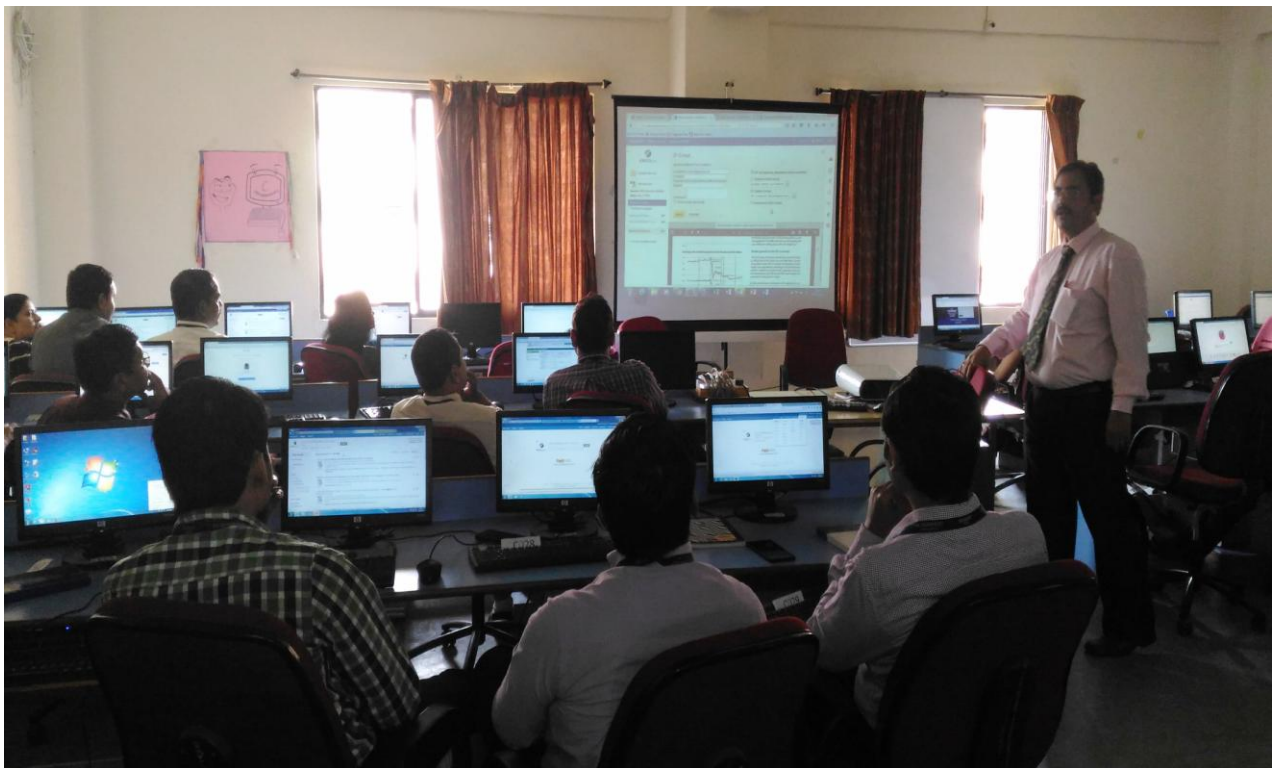
