1.0 PURPOSE: To define a procedure for slow learners and advance learners separately at ZIBACAR

3.0 PROCEDURE:

1. Identify course wise slow learners based on Concurrent Internal Evaluation (CIE) and Midterm/ End term Result.
2. Based on above mentioned parameters, students having marks above 70% would be identified as Advance Learners, below 50% would be identified as slow learners.

A. For Slow Learners:

1. Schedule the course specific extra / Remedial sessions for these students to clarify their doubts for an improved performance
2. Peer learning Activity / pair them with brighter students in group activities
3. Individual and Group Assignments are given and evaluated on a regular basis.
4. Mentor- mentee sessions are conducted.

B. For Advance Learners:

1. Allot advanced assignments having higher levels of Blooms taxonomy and get it completed.
2. Recommend course specific co-curricular activities like NPTEL/Advanced courses/ Seminars/Conferences/Technical Events/ Model making competition/ industrial visits /industry sponsored internships, any other.
3. Advanced learners are encouraged to help and provide support to the weaker students by engaging in group discussions
