- 3. Individual and Group Assignments are given and evaluated on a regular basis.
- 4. Mentor- mentee sessions are conducted.

B. For Advance Learners:

- 1. Allot advanced assignments having higher levels of Blooms taxonomy and get it completed.
- Recommend course specific co-curricular activities like NPTEL/Advanced courses/ Seminars/Conferences/Technical Events/ Model making competition/ industrial visits /industry sponsored internships, any other.
- 3. Advanced learners are encouraged to help and provide support to the weaker students by engaging in group discussions
