

The campus has an effcient system for waste management. The housekeeping team takes care of this segregation of solid waste which mainly includes waste paper, garden waste, and plastic waste. Handling over the collected waste in a segregated manner to local authorities is practiced every alternate day. No biomedical waste is generated on the campus. In case of any occasions like blood donation camps, sports, etc.; care is taken to hand over the biomedical waste to authorized agencies whenever required.


